



Prosser Community Youth Volunteer Scholarship

Award:

- A maximum of two recipients
- \$2,000 has been allocated for this award by the Prosser Community Volunteers
- Amount can be allocated between the two recipients based on a ratio of community service hours from the Wednesday PVC activity.
- Scholarship checks will be sent out directly to the student

Requirements:

- Senior of Prosser High School on track to graduate OR Student enrolled in online schooling or a homeschool program
- Minimum of 18 hours of service with Prosser Community Volunteer Wednesday youth activity during their senior year.

Award will be based on:

- Meeting the minimum 18 hours of service at the PCV a Wednesday youth activity during their senior year.
- Essay submission on what the applicant learned during their service with the Prosser Community Volunteers projects. Essay should be no more than 2 pages, 500–1500-word limit.
- Observation of personal development and selfless service and leadership over time with the volunteer group
- Positive impact on the projects and fellow volunteers during their service time

Scholarship Board:

- A minimum of two adult volunteers from the Prosser Community Volunteers group who has partnered with the youth on projects
- Two Board of Governance members

Timeline of Award:

- Decision made in early May based on prior summer/ current school year opportunities
- Award announced at annual PHS Scholarship Night

Submission of Essay:

- Essay submitted to Angela Skeen at Prosser High School Room 233 no later than April 30th, 2027.
